### 2020 MEMBERSHIP FEE

1<sup>ST</sup> PAYMENT DUE 12/20/19  
50% of the membership fee due

2<sup>ND</sup> PAYMENT DUE 1/12/20  
remaining 50% member fee due

### ADDITIONAL PURCHASES

Members are responsible for providing their own matte black marching shoes and long black socks.

Shoes are the personal property of each member and are the sole responsibility of the individual.

Hair/makeup accessories may be required for costuming as an individual member responsibility. This purchase, if necessary, will be nominal.

## WHY DO WE HAVE FEES?

### REGISTRATIONS:

It costs several hundred dollars each season for competition registrations.

### EQUIPMENT & MAINTENANCE:

Heads, sticks, mallets, etc all cost a significant amount of money. While we are able to use Falcon Band equipment free of charge, it is our responsibility to maintain the equipment we use.

### UNIFORMS, PROPS, & SHIRTS:

Uniforms cost well over \$100.00 per member and each member will receive a show shirt for participation in the season. Props used for show performance also cost money to supply and build.
